We are unable to test your vehicle due to the problem(s) checked below. There is no fee charged at this time. We recommend making **only** the check-marked repair(s) or adjustment(s) for now.

- Exhaust system leak:** We saw possible leaks in the exhaust system.

A leak can draw in fresh air, which mixes with exhaust gases. This can cause a false test result. Exhaust system leaks can also expose people inside the vehicle to harmful, odorless fumes.

What to do: Have this problem checked and repaired. We also recommend checking for and repairing any other exhaust system leaks.

- Idle speed too high:** We cannot inspect a vehicle that idles faster than 1,100 revolutions per minute (RPM).

What to do: **Only** have the engine idle speed adjusted to the vehicle manufacturer's specifications.

- Safety:** It was unsafe for our staff to test your vehicle due to: **Fluid Leak** **Overheating**

What to do: Have this condition repaired/corrected.
