Asbestos Requirements

Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 40, Part 61.145©(10): “If a facility is demolished by intentional burning, all regulated asbestos containing material, including category I and category II nonfriable asbestos containing material, must be removed in accordance with the NESHAP before burning.”

To meet asbestos requirements:

1. An AHERA certified asbestos inspector must inspect for the presence of asbestos prior to the proposed burn. Asbestos must be removed prior to burning.
2. The owner of the building, the asbestos abatement contractor (if asbestos is to be removed by the contractor), or the fire department must submit an “Asbestos Notification of Demolition and Renovation” form to Ecology at least 10 working days before asbestos removal or the training activity takes place. This form is included with this application for a Fire Training Permit.
