DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal:

The State Solid and Hazardous Waste Plan (Moving Washington Beyond Waste and Toxics). This required five year update continues the 30 year vision of the 2004 and 2009 Beyond Waste plan for the management of solid and hazardous waste in Washington. With this update the plan name has changed slightly. The structure of the plan has also changed, though all key solid and hazardous waste management elements remain. A sustainable materials management focus has been added, as endorsed by the Environmental Protection Agency.

Proponent: Department of Ecology, Waste 2 Resources and Hazardous Waste & Toxic Reduction Programs

Location of proposal, including street address, if any

The State Solid and Hazardous Waste Plan (Moving Washington Beyond Waste and Toxics) applies to the entire state of Washington. The plan is not required but sets direction for Ecology and other appropriate state agency staff, local governments as they update and implement their local solid and hazardous waste plans, businesses, including regulated hazardous waste generators, pertinent non-governmental organizations, and other interested parties.

Lead agency: Department of Ecology

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030 (2)(c). This decision was made after review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency. This information is available to the public on request.
